## HEMPHILL COUNTY EXTENSION OF DISASTER DECLARATION

## **COMMISSIONER COURT ORDER**

WHEREAS, On February 27, 2024, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Hemphill County resulting from

Loss of property and loss of livestock due to wildfire

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaring of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF HEMPHILL COUNTY:

- 1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the County of Hemphill by the County Judge on February 27, 2024 shall continue until 11:59 p.m. March 17, 2024.
- 2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code and shall become effective on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 2024.
