COMMISSIONER COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, On February 27, 2024, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Hemphill County resulting from

Loss of property and loss of livestock due to wildfire


WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaring of a state of disaster continue to exist; and


WHEREAS, 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF HEMPHILL COUNTY:


1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the County of Hemphill by the County Judge on February 27, 2024 shall continue until 11:59 p.m. March 17, 2024.
2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code and shall become effective on the 10th day of March 2024.


