

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals addressed to the Honorable George Briant, County Judge, Hemphill County, for the construction of up to two pre-engineered covered canopies will be received at the office of Hemphill County Judge, Hemphill County Courthouse, 400 Main Street, Canadian, Texas 79014 until: 9:00 a.m., June 11, 2018. Bids shall be clearly marked "SEALED BID—COVERED CANOPIES" on the envelope and shall be identified with the bidder's name and address.

A cashier's check, certified check or acceptable bidder's bond, payable to Hemphill County in an amount equal to not less than five percent of the bid submitted, must accompany each bid as guarantee that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will, within ten days after receipt of contract documents, enter into a contract with the owner and will execute bonds on the forms provided in the contract documents. Any bid received after the time and date listed above will be returned unopened and will not be considered.

Bidders are expected to inspect the site of the work and inform themselves regarding all local conditions.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from George Briant, County Judge at the above noted address, telephone (806) 323.6521. Cost: Fifty and No/100th Dollars (\$50.00), non-refundable, for each set of plans and specifications.

Performance and payment bonds shall be set forth in the contract documents.

Successful bidder shall provide proof of liability insurance coverage in an amount not less than One Million and No/100th Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) with Hemphill County named as "Additional Insured."

The owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in the bidding. In case of ambiguity or lack of clearness, the owner reserves the right to adopt such interpretations as may be most advantageous or to reject the bid as informal. No bid may be withdrawn until the expiration of 30 days from the bid opening date.
