Receive Collections Report from Perdue Brandon Fielder Collins & Mott.

Brent Sherrod and Bill Pinkham with Perdue Brandon Fielder Collins & Mott Firm presented to the court the collection report. Brent said the firm helps the county collect delinquent taxes, fines and fees. Bill presented to the court the 2023 tax year calendar. He went over the tax collection process.

Receive Audit Report from Doshier, Pickens and Francis CPS firm for year ending September 30, 2023.

John Merriss with Doshier, Pickens & Francis LLC CPA Firm presented to the court the Annual Financial Report for the year ending in September 30, 2023. He went over the Statement of Net Position. The county end of the year cash equivalence is \$25,704,126. Delinquent receivable, net is \$127,698, which is up from last year due to litigation with the Appraisal District. Net pension assets are \$5,329,347. John went over the expenses of the county, direct charges for services and general revenue. The report was received by the court without issues. Tim moved to accept the audit report from Doshier, Pickens & Francis CPA for the year ending September 30, 2023. Nicholas seconded the motion which carried unopposed.

Consider / Approve Street for 2024 Sealcoat Project

Tim moved to approve the 2024 street seal coat projects as presented. Dale seconded the motion which carried unopposed.

Consider / Approve 2024-2025 Hemphill County Airport Premises Liability Insurance.

Dale moved to approve the liability insurance for the airport at a cost of \$5445.00. Tim seconded the motion which carried unopposed.
