If a defendant is charged with committing an offense punishable as a felony, while released on bail in a pending case for another offense punishable as a felony, and the subsequent offense is committed in Hill County, Texas, the defendant's bail may be set at an amount deemed appropriate by Judge Doyle "Trey" Jetton, an elected Justice of the Peace in and for Hill County, Texas in no event, however, may that subsequent bail be a personal or signature bond.

This Order shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
