A tax rate of \$0.757366 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Canadian.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.757366per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.757366per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.897009 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City of Canadian from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that the City of Canadian may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that the City of Canadian is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE TO ADOPT THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21 AT 5:30 AT THE CITY COUNCIL BOARDROOM .

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, the City of Canadian is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the City Council or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS: Property tax amount= (tax rate) x (taxable value of your property)/100

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Canadian last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Canadian this year.

Total tax levy on all properties	\$1,105,510	\$1,069,062	decrease of \$-36,448, or -3.30%
