

# NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.571082 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Hemphill County Hospital District.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Hemphill County Hospital District from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Hemphill County Hospital District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Hemphill County Hospital District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 18, 2026 AT 5:00 PM in the Hemphill County Hospital Boardroom.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Hemphill County Hospital District is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Hemphill County Hospital District at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.
