

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

Hemphill County, TEXAS

A tax rate of \$0.550000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.550000 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.595334 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.755055 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 31, 2026 AT 9:00 AM AT Hemphill County Courthouse Commissioner's Courtroom.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Commissioner's Court of Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED
AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Hemphill County & County Road & Bridge this year.

Average homestead taxable value	\$108,452	\$122,417	increase of 12.88%
Tax on average homestead	\$574.80	\$673.29	increase of 98.49, or 17.13%
Total tax levy on all properties	\$5,923,105	\$5,436,538	decrease of -486,567, or -8.21%
