Hemphill County Cemetery Lot Policy

- 1. The minimum outer burial container is required. (For casketed remains)
- 2. Hemphill County Cemeteries are not perpetual care cemeteries. Hemphill County mows & trims cemeteries; but any further maintenance is the responsibility of the lot owner or family.
- 3. Lot cost: Payable to Hemphill County

\$200 per casket burial space, initial purchase

\$150 cremation burial space in Serenity Gardens

\$100 Second Rite of Interment, cremains buried on an existing burial space

This fee includes the cost of the marking fee.

\$75 Marking fee, casket burial, monument placement, initial cremation burial No cost for burial in Garden of Angels

- 4. Families are responsible for removing debris from personal lots.
- 5. NO evergreen plantings without the approval of the Association Board.
- 6. One half or a full burial space is required for planting trees provided that the mature tree does not exceed the dimensions of the lot.
- 7. Hemphill County maintains the right to trim or remove any plantings that infringe onto other lots, walkways & driveways!
- 8. If chat is used, no chat may be placed on lots without a curb barrier. When using chat, a concrete floor with scored lines or a grave door for unopened grave spaces is required. When a space is opened for burial, the opened space is to be covered with a fresh concrete pour within one year. A (1-2) chat size is to be used, no lava rock.
- 9. If curbing is to be installed commercial curbing is required. Curbing is to be placed within the lot boundaries.
- 10. Retaining wall requests will be brought before the Association Board for consideration and approval.

11. Watering Policy:

1 hour a day; Maximum 3 days a week, not to exceed 1" of water a week
