Proposed Policy Changes

Effective January 1, 2016

Hemphill County Cemetery Lot Policy

1. The minimum outer burial container is required. *(For casketed remains)*
2. Hemphill County Cemeteries are not perpetual care cemeteries. Hemphill County mows & trims cemeteries; but any further maintenance is the responsibility of the lot owner or family.
3. Families are responsible for removing debris from personal lots.
4. Florist: Please remove metal easel stands following graveside services.
5. NO evergreen plantings without the approval of the Association Board.
6. One half or a full burial space is required for planting trees provided that the mature tree does not exceed the dimensions of the lot.
7. Hemphill County maintains the right to trim or remove any plantings that infringe onto other lots, walkways & driveways!
8. If chat or rock is used, no chat or rock may be placed on lots without a curb barrier. When using chat a concrete floor with scored lines for unopened grave spaces is suggested for the floor of the lot. When a space is opened for burial, the opened space is to be covered with a fresh concrete pour within one year. A (1-2) chat size is recommended.
9. If curbing is to be installed commercial curbing is recommended. Curbing is to be placed within the lot boundaries.
10. All retaining wall requests will be brought before the Association Board for consideration and approval.

Watering Policy: 1 hour a day, **Maximum** 3 days a week, not to exceed 1" of water a week.
